



## Preservation Awards

Since 1983, Historic Salisbury Foundation has celebrated local historic preservation successes by presenting Preservation Awards to individuals, companies, and projects demonstrating various areas of excellence in preservation.

The Awards Committee, made up of members of the Foundation's Board of Trustees and various community leaders, meets each year to solicit nominations, evaluate the merits of each individual and/or project, and then recommends a slate of recipients to the Board of Trustees for approval. Nominations are accepted year-round.

Award categories include the following (additional categories may be added from time to time and awards need not be given in every category each year):

### **Commercial Revitalization through Historic Preservation**

This award recognizes excellence in commercial or industrial revitalization through the use of historic preservation in the rehabilitation or adaptive reuse of an existing structure. This award may also be given to recognize outstanding new infill construction that adapts scale, architectural features, and materials from neighboring buildings and incorporates them in the construction.

### **Private Preservation and Neighborhood Revitalization**

This award recognizes excellence for private preservation projects, substantial changes towards more original features or appearance, or positive efforts in neighborhood revitalization, especially in neighborhoods targeted by the Foundation's Neighborhood Revitalization Committee.

### **Long Time Preservation Leaders**

This award recognizes individuals who have demonstrated a long-term commitment to historic preservation either through service to Historic Salisbury Foundation, Inc., their neighborhood, or a specific project.

### **Preservation Education and Publication**

This award recognizes either individuals or projects that have made an outstanding contribution to preservation through education of the public or by publication of scholarly works on history, genealogy, historic architecture, or historic preservation.

### **Preservation Craftsmen and Professionals**

This award recognizes a craftsman or professional whose actions and leadership exemplify an understanding of and effective professional practice in working with historic buildings and sites.

### **Volunteer of the Year**

This award recognizes an individual or family for exceptional commitment of time and talents to Historic Salisbury Foundation, Inc. during the previous year. The recipient's personal generosity should motivate others to become active volunteers.
